Post-Operative Instructions for Laser Surgery (Plantar Wart)

- 1. Stay off foot for 12 to 24 hours. Keep foot elevated during this time.
- 2. Ice packs, 15 minutes on & 15 minutes off, if needed, for pain.
- 3. Use plain Tylenol for pain, 1 or 2 tablets every 4 hours as needed.
- 4. Remove dressing in morning. Cleanse with Betadine Solution. Apply 2" x 2" or 3" x 3" gauze pad with adhesive tape.
- 5. If blood seeps through bandage on day of surgery, apply sterile bandage over the original dressing. **Do not Remove Original Dressing Until Morning!**
